OPPORTUNITY FOR MUSIC FUNDING TO SUPPORT BRADFORD SCHOOLS' JOINT WORKING – COLLABORATIVE GROUP MINI PROM

The Bradford Music Education Hub is in a position to offer funding for schools within Bradford MDC to enable them to work more coherently as a collective by way of producing a collaborative joint Mini School's Prom. These monies can be used in various ways – some examples are as below:

- Venue Hire
- Technicians
- Administration/Management time
- Marketing/Printing
- Ticket Sales
- Hospitality
- Staging
- Video/photography

Each school group can apply for a maximum of £4,500 (£500 per school participating) if all funding conditions are met.

Each group of schools must identify one lead school to apply and ALL schools within that group must make a firm commitment take part in the Mini Prom. A minimum of 4 schools per group is required. Each school can only be involved in one Mini Prom group. The Mini Prom can be varied including vocalists/instrumentalists (individual or groups), dancers, magicians, theatre – no restrictions - whatever works best for your school group.

Should you wish to be involved and are unable to meet the minimum requirement of 4 schools in a group please submit your request we may be able to pair you up with other schools in a similar position.

Funding will be sent to schools to start planning this collaborative group work week commencing 8 July 2019. The group Mini prom should take place in the Autumn Term - September-December 2019. Once the Mini Prom has taken place an evaluation/report must be undertaken by each school in the group. One member of staff from each school participating must attend an evaluation meeting following the conclusion of all of the mini proms at the start of the Spring Term to share experiences and build on lessons learned during this process.

From each participating group of schools details of 2 Acts should be recommended to be put forward for the main Schools' Proms 2020 to perform on the 31 March 2020 or 1 April 2020 (there is no guarantee that both acts will obtain a place in the Schools' Prom at St George's Hall).

Schools must apply by 28 June 2019 on the attached form.

Applications will be dealt with on a first come first served basis.
